


MONDAY -Comparing Amounts


TUESDAY - Totaling I have come to the toy shop to buy some toys. What could I buy and how much would it cost me?

When we pay with too much, we have to have change given back to us, otherwise it wouldn't be fair.


Can you work out the change you would get from 10p if you bought these items?

You might need to add the 2 items together first!








English – Tuesday and Wednesday Story Sequencing

When you have done that, can you write a sentence to go with the picture?




English – Thursday Vocabulary

Other Insects that Complete Metamorphosis








English – Friday

This is some of the information from the life cycle we looked at yesterday. Can you cut out the pieces and put them in order to create a life cycle.

You will need 4 steps.

Pupa / Chrysalis	Caterpillar	Adult butterfly	Eggs
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The butterfly lays eggs on leaves.	The egg hatches into a caterpillar, which eats leaves, and grows until it is ready to turn into a pupa/chrysalis.	
The body of the butterfly develops inside this.	The butterfly emerges from the pupa and flies off to find flowers to feed from.
