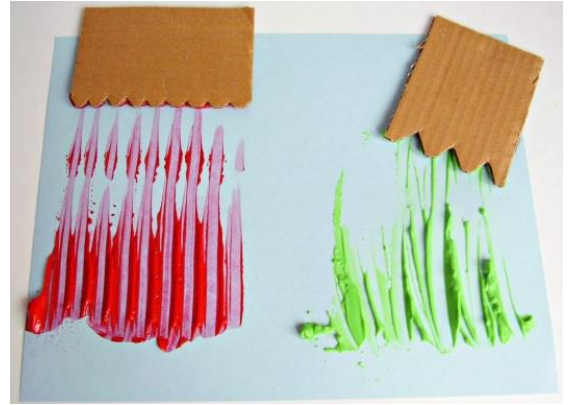


Cardboard Painting Tools

You can easily make a simple painting tool with corrugated cardboard that will provide lots of opportunity for process art!

Children tend to love this kind of art because they only need minimal instruction to provide oodles of creative fun!



What you need:

- Paper or card
- Scissors
- Pieces of cardboard



What to do:

1. Cut notches in one side of a piece of corrugated cardboard.
2. Vary the notches to create different patterns in paint.
3. Pour a row of washable kids' paint onto construction paper or card stock.
4. Glide the painting tool through the paint to create a design.
