## 1) Role-play: Coffee shop

## What you need:

- plates, mugs, cutlery, a jug/teapot (real ones are ok too)
- ground coffee and tea bags to brew.
- Food: can be real fruits, potatoes, large beans, stock cubes, dry pasta and pretend these are cakes, biscuits, sandwiches etc. note pad and pens for taking orders.
- kitchen towel to mop up spillage of water.

Probably best to play outside and pretend it's a beach café.



## Play:

Order coffee/drinks, pastries, cakes etc. and let your child serve you. If he/she is not confident to do this, be the waiter first and model play. You could design a menu together: draw or write the items, or cut out pictures of magazines. Add prices so you can pretend paying at the end and your child can count if you have given enough money. You could cut out circles/squares from card to use as money.
