

Role-play: Car wash

What you need:

- An empty plastic box- cut out a door at both sides.
- Foam or plastic sheets or any fabric
- Duct tape, PVA glue or glue gun
- Lolly sticks or tree twigs (optional)
- Sponge (optional)
- Shaving foam
- towel



1. Cut narrow lines in the foam sheets or the fabric, leaving 2cm at the top. Glue this into the box by one of the doors.



2. You could add another door like this at the other side or try to make rollers. You could stick foam/fabric on lolly sticks or tree twigs but you'll probably need glue gun to fix these onto the box. (Cut holes to press the lolly stick through, then glue these to another lolly stick to hold them in place)



3. Decorate the box if your child wants to.
4. Add a bowl of shaving foam to pretend that's the car washing soap. This could be put on the cars or the rollers and curtains of the box. Car goes in, comes out, gets rinsed in water, then polished with a towel. Pretend paying for the wash.
5. Extra:
Make price lists, posters, pretend money. You could add a road map that leads to the car wash by drawing the map with chalk on the floor, drawing one on paper or printing the map attached here.
