

Frozen animals

What you need:

- A big bowl that fits in your freezer's drawer
- Plastic animals, but you could use any of your child's favourite toys (have to be waterproof though!)
- Food colouring - optional

Put your child's toy animals in a big bowl, pour water over them. Colour water with food colouring if you feel like. Put in the freezer for at least a day.

When all frozen, take it out, put it in the sun and talk to your child about how you could rescue the animals from the 'Big Freeze'. They might come up with ideas from hammering the ice to break it to spraying it with warm water or leaving the block in the Sun to melt completely.

Other things you could freeze:

Flowers, leaves, twigs, pebbles, pom poms, spices, cars, etc.
