For the play dough/clay you will need -

Playdough ingredients

1/2 cup of water

2 cups of flour

Food colouring - optional

Playdough ingredients -

2 cups all-purpose flour.

3/4 cup salt.

4 teaspoons cream of tartar.

2 cups lukewarm water.

2 Tablespoons of vegetable oil (coconut oil works too)

Food colouring - optional.

Any other colours of your choice

Yellow paint
Green paint
Any other paint colours of your choice
Paint brush
