

Chinese New Year celebration is here soon, so we start making things for this.


What you need:

Coloured paper / or white paper coloured in Scissors
String




<u>Parents to</u> draw a bit and small triangle for the dragon's head and tail and a long rectangle.

<u>Children to cut</u> the triangles and the rectangle out, then cut strips from the rectangle, like this:




If you have white paper, ask the children to colour them in.

Children to glue the strips of paper on the string. If this doesn't work, use sellotape to fix the strips on the string. The children should practise cutting and positioning the sellotape! Add the big triangle for the head and the small for the end of the tail. The children can draw the eyes and teeth.

It is nearly Chinese New Year! We will be learning little bits about this as the week progresses. It would be really lovely if you could have a try at making a Chinese New Year card. Here is a template. It has the Ox on, which is the animal of 2021. If you do not have a printer, that is OK. You can draw and design your own card. Have a look for ideas on the internet. 


Science - What is the weather like?


