
Children to have their sound mat in front of them. Parent to call out a sound, children to find them. Then take turns.

read and copy tricky words on paper











- 1) Robot talk S-U-N= sun.
 2) Chn to cirlce the letters on the sound mat.
 3) Chn to write the word.



- Robot talk M-U-M= mum.
 Circle the letters on the sound mat.
 Chn to write the word.










- 1) Robot talk F-U-N= fun
 2) Circle the letters on the sound mat.
 3) Chn to write the word.



Write: Mum is fun. Say sentence, clap it. Use the sound mat to help you write the sentence.



- Robot talk D-U-G
 Circle the letters on the sound mat.
 Chn to write the word.



- Robot talk P-I-T= pit
 Circle the letters on the sound mat.
 Chn to write the word.




Write: Jim dug a pit. Say sentence, clap it out. Parents to model writing it. Then children have a go. Make sure there is space between words.



What else could you do?

1) practise writing words and letters on paper / in flour / sand eg: but, bad, dad, dig, hot, can



Say word in robot talk, look up letters on the sound mat, write the word. Use the words from the Bear Words cards.

2) Read - run - write -check

Have words written on a card. Child to read 1 card, then run to the other side of the room to write the word. Run back to collect the card to check if it's correctly written. This can be done 1 letter at a time too.
