# Query 1

When the Second World War broke out, she joined the French Resistance (the Marquis) in their fight against the Nazis. Nancy enrolled as an ambulance driver and began helping the trapped British soldiers to escape back home. She outwitted the German secret police (the Gestapo) at every turn and was soon top of their Most Wanted list. They nicknamed her The White Mouse, because she seemed impossible to catch! In 1943, she was discovered and fled France.
