She can be a little bit naughty and sometimes she does silly things but she is here to help us with our Phonics.






First, Pop would like us to think about the letters and sounds we have learned.


She wants to make sure we can remember the name of each of the letters and the sound that letter makes.

S snake is in the grass 3 times 1 - Bing video








Wiggle fingers above elbow as if ants crawling on you, and say *a*, *a*, *a*!






Action Children imitate watching tennis,turning head from side to side,and saying t,t,t,t.








Hold up index finger,as if it is a lit candle,and imagine puffing it out,saying p,p,p.









Action Pretend to be a mouse,by wiggling fingers on end of your nose(whiskers) and squeak i, i, i .




Well done. You have remembered the first set of sounds we have learned.







Action Pretend to hold egg with one hand, as if cracking it against the side of a bowl or pan. Use both hands to open shell, saying eh, eh, eh




Action Place one hand above the other, lower the top hand as if an inflatable fish is deflating, and say fffffff.





Next, Pop wants us to learn about digraphs.
















Now, Pop wants us to learn about trigraphs.


A trigraph is when we put three letters together to make a new sound.


Pop wants us to practise our tricky words.




