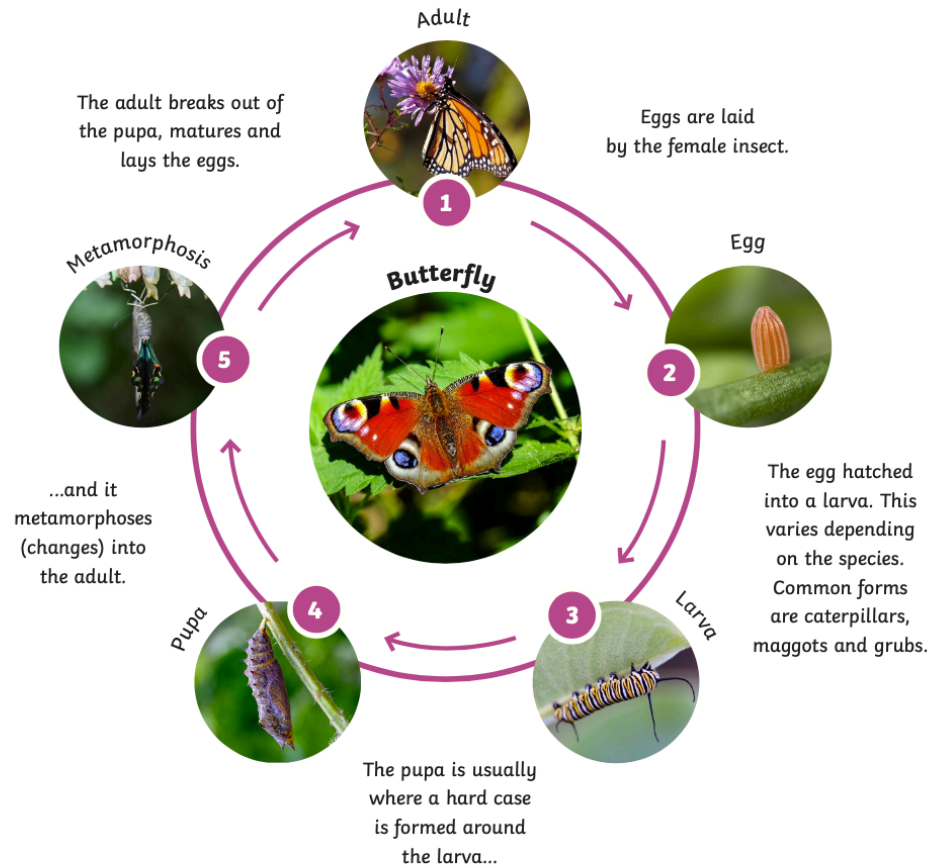

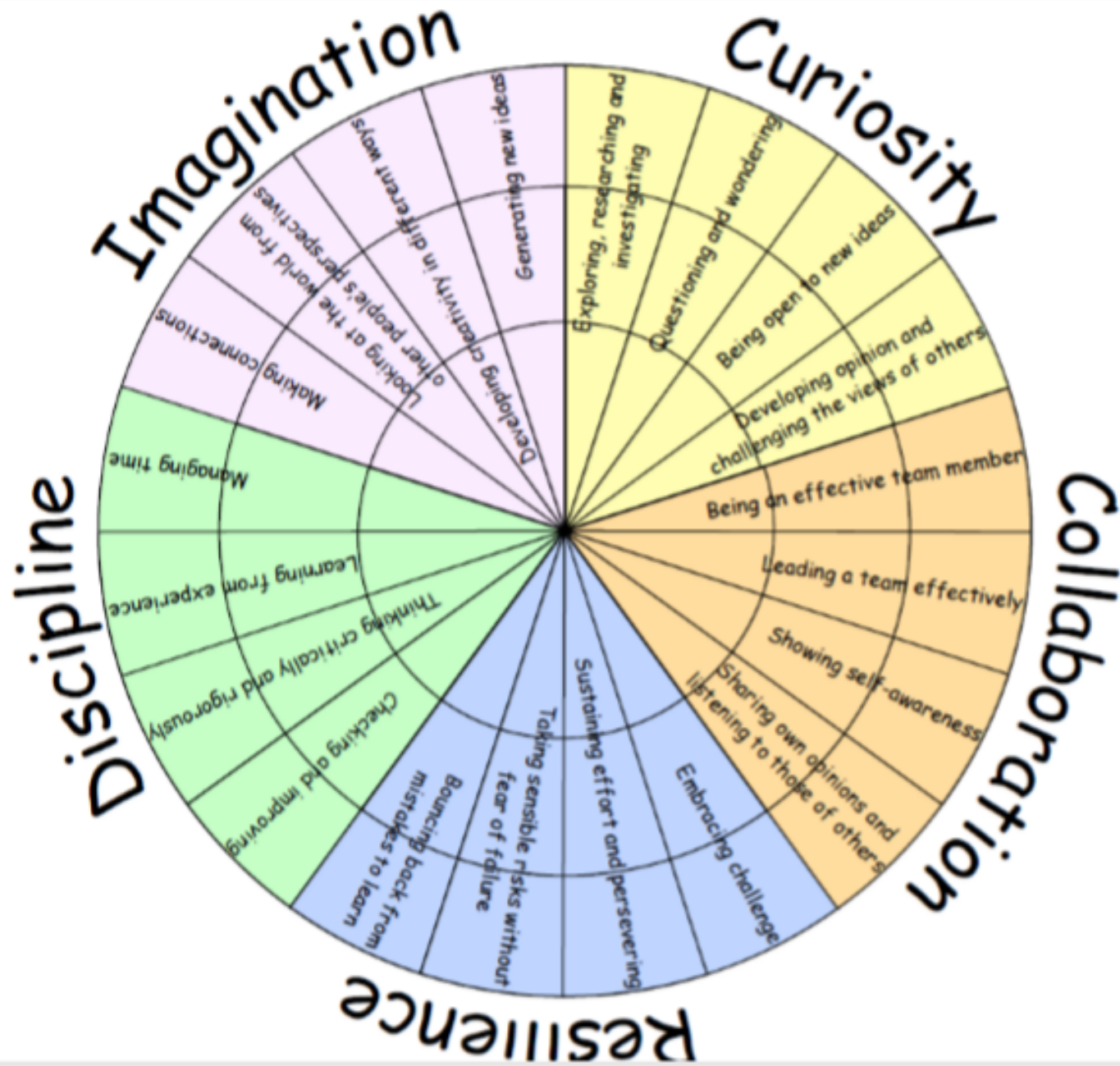

Pupa / Chrysalis	Caterpillar	Adult butterfly	Eggs
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The butterfly lays eggs on leaves.	The egg hatches into a caterpillar, which eats leaves, and grows until it is ready to turn into a pupa/chrysalis.		
The body of the butterfly develops inside this.	The butterfly emerges from the pupa and flies off to find flowers to feed from.
