



Edit and improve your non- chronological report on	Step 1	Think of a catchy title and three succinct subheadings	<ul> <li>Large-sized, capital letters - title.</li> <li>Medium-sized, underlined, capital letters of subheadings.</li> </ul>
preparing Tutankhamun for the afterlife (mummification, objects in his tomb – linked to his beliefs).	Step 2	Add factual information beneath each subheading.	<ul> <li>Factual information</li> <li>Historical vocabulary (brackets)</li> <li>Subject-specific language</li> <li>Third person (Tutankhamun, he, the body, his mummy)</li> <li>Fronted adverbials for sequence</li> </ul>
