Adding -ing

If the word has a short vowel sound, you double the consonant and add ing.

If the word has a long vowel sound, you just add ing.

If the word ends in a y, you change the y to an i and add ing.

If the word ends in an e, you take away the e and add ing.

- Follow the rules to add the suffix -ing.
- Short vowel sound - a, e, i, o, u
- Long vowel sound - A, E, I, O, U
- Can you think of your own verbs and add -ing. Don't forget to follow the rules!
