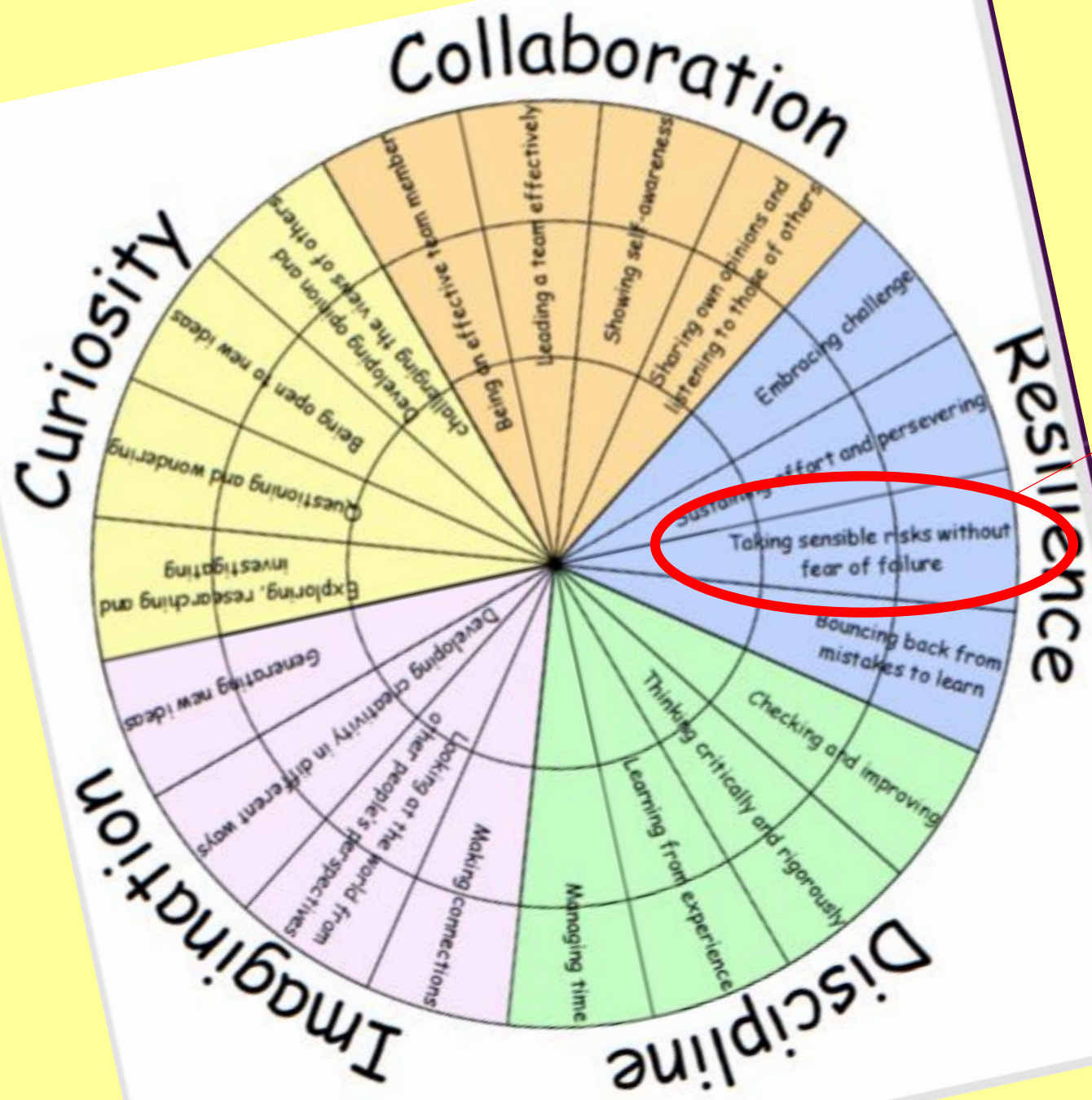

# How will you use your voice?

This was a formal (serious) piece of writing, so you should try to make your voice sound serious when you read it.

Make sure you practise a few times so that you can pronounce any tricky words properly and follow the punctuation in your writing accurately.

# Think about...

- The volume of your voice
- The speed of your reading (it should be fluent, but not so fast that the listener can't understand!)
- When you will take a pause. The punctuation in your writing will guide you here.
- Top tip: imagine you are a TV newsreader. This will give your voice a suitable tone.
