International transportation involves the movement of people or goods between countries. Depending on what is being transported, and how quickly it needs to arrive at its destination, different forms of transport are used. Almost all international travel causes pollution and therefore needs to be managed. Tourism and the trade of goods and services between countries are the main reasons for international transportation.

Why might tourism be important to a country?


Possible answers:

This map shows the main shipping routes for trade around the world. The areas in red and yellow show the busiest routes. <u>Cargo</u> ships carry goods in large quantities. The biggest port in the world is Shanghai in China.
