There are exceptions. For example, "science".

For when dreams go
Life is a barren field Frozen with snow.

## Why do you think this is referred to as a "structured" poem?

The author wants to give the reader a clear message. So he has thought carefully about the animal and the rhyming words (they link and make sense).

Hold fast to dreams For if dreams die Life is a broken-winged bird That cannot fly.

Hold fast to dreams For when dreams go Life is a barren field Frozen with snow.

Only "die" and "fly" rhyme. Notice, words that rhyme can have different spelling patterns.

| die | fly |
| :--- | :--- |
| pass away | glide |
| depart | soar |
| expire | flutter |
