One of the best-known African drums is the West African djembe (pronounced zhem-bay).


It is shaped like a large goblet and played with bare hands. The body is carved from a hollowed trunk and is covered in goat skin.

The influence of African music is widespread.


It went to America and combined with folk music it produced new styles of music such as blues, gospel and jazz.
