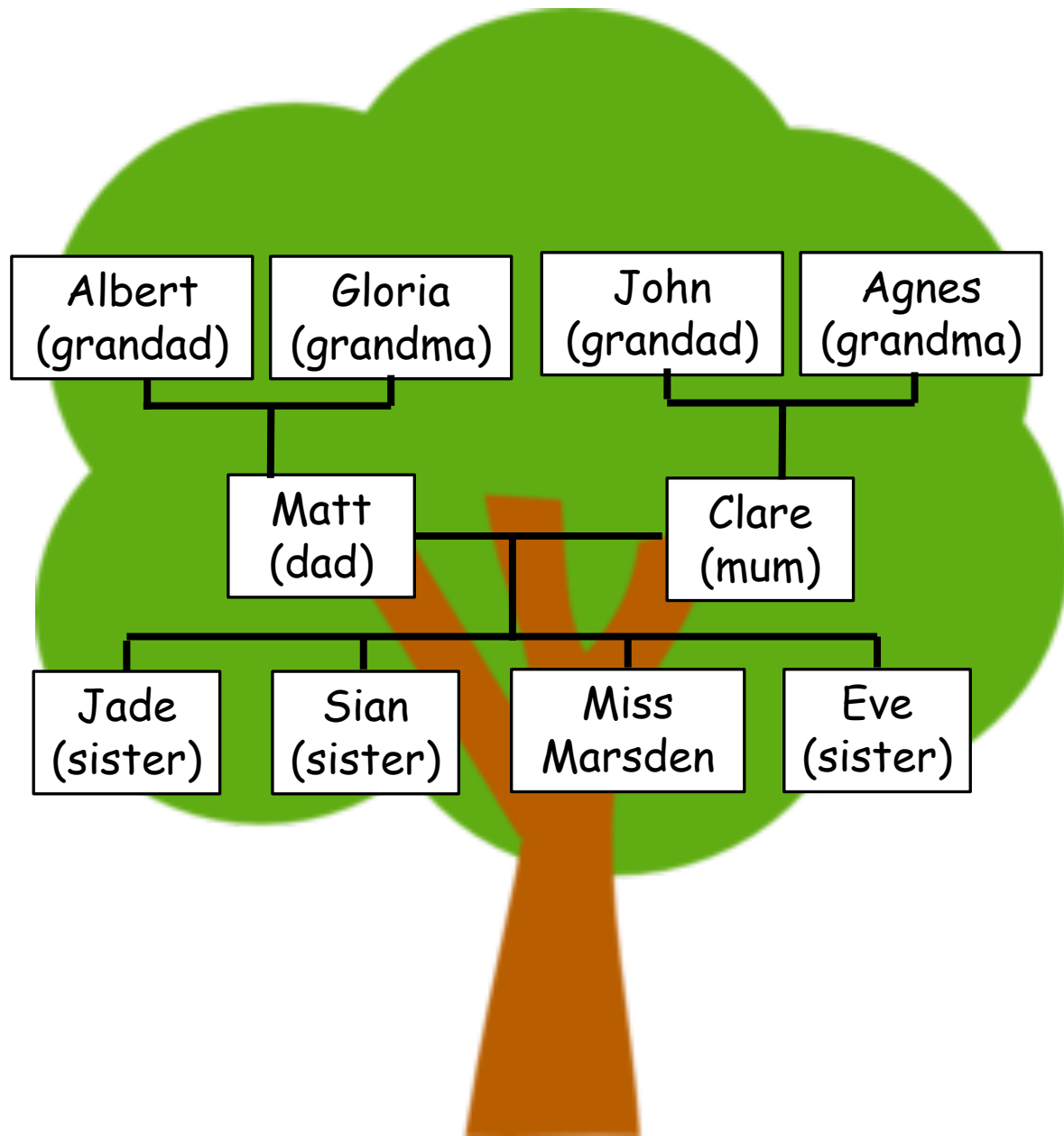

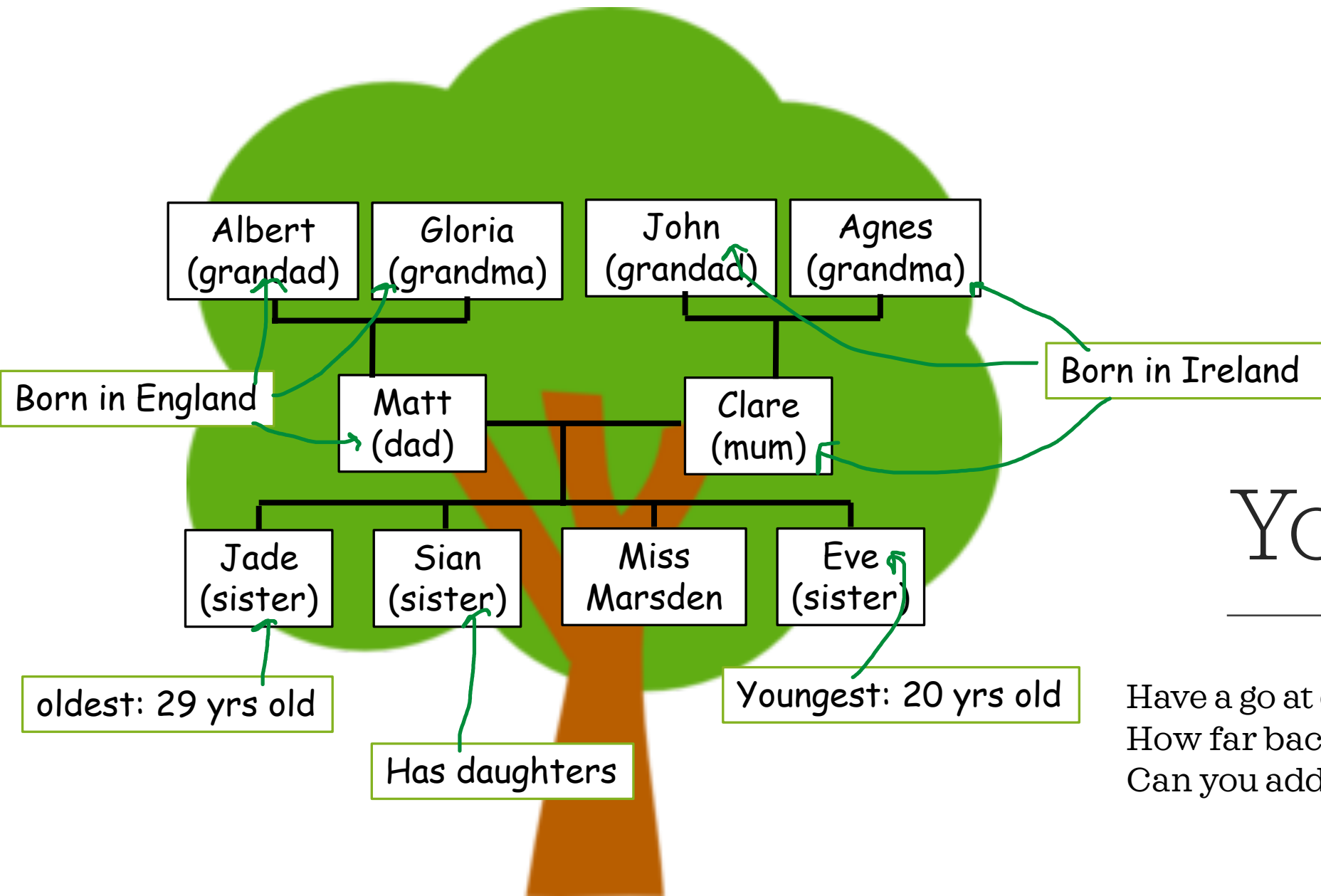




# This is Miss Marsden's family tree
